Current Job Posting Trends¹

Dudley Overview

- Between July to September 2024 (inclusive), there were 6,129 unique job adverts for roles recorded in Dudley. This number of postings is average compared to all local authority districts.
 Over the past year, this has decreased by 29.5%, compared to a decrease of 28.1% across the UK.
- During this period, there were 4,770 new job postings. This number of postings is average compared to all local authority districts. Over the past year, this has decreased by 30.2% compared to a decrease of 29.3% across the UK.

Demand and Interest Trend:



- Over this quarter, live postings adverts have increased by 4.4%, whilst new job postings have decreased by 26.7% during this period. This signals the cooling off of the labour market.
- More recently, demand has seemingly picked up again, as live postings have increased 8.4% in the
 last 30 days of job posting activity, new postings have also increased by 19.4%, showing changing
 near-term trends.
- By comparing interest quotient and demand, we can identify where there are mismatches in talent/supply and demand. Interest Quotient is ranked at a high of 1.7.

Dudley Advertised Salary

• The advertised median salary for roles over this period in Dudley was £31,990 – up by 13.0% from the previous year, but 4.3% less than the overall national median salary of £33,423.

Top Occupations

- The top posted occupations below account for 10.9% of all job postings in this quarter.
- Primary school teachers are the most in demand occupations, receiving the highest number of postings in the area.
- Social care workers are the most in demand vacancies from the employee perspective, receiving the highest interest in terms of clicks and applicants.
- Installers have the highest location quotient, and maintenance engineers have the highest salary.



 Reflecting the most advertised occupations, the biggest skills gaps are around 'communication', 'clients' and 'management'.





• By volume Tesco have logged the most job postings, but posting is also high for Dudley Council.



Dudley Total Claimants²

 Dudley had 10,305 claimants aged 16 years and over in August 2024, an increase of 135 (+1.3%) from the previous month. Compared to August 2023, claimants in Dudley increased by 1,345 (+15.0%).


- Out of the 24 wards within Dudley, 13 were at or above the UK average of 3.3%.
- The wards with the highest number of claimants as a percentage of residents aged 16 years and over were St Thomas's at 8.4%, St James's at 6.2% and Netherton, Woodside & St Andrews and Brierley Hill both at 6.1%.

Dudley Youth Claimants

Dudley had 1,810 youth claimants in August 2024, an increase of 35 (+2.0%) since July 2024. When compared to August 2023, the number of youth claimants increased by 50 (+2.8%).

- Challenges remain with youth claimants as 17 out of 24 wards in Dudley were above the UK average of 4.2% in August 2024.
- The wards with the highest number of claimants as a percentage of residents aged 16-24 were Castle & Priory at 10.3%, St Thomas's at 9.3% and St James's at 7.8%.
