

Current Job Posting Trends¹

Sandwell Overview

- Between October to December 2024 (inclusive), there were 7,025 unique job adverts for roles recorded in Sandwell. This number of postings is high compared to all local authority districts.
 Over the past year, this has decreased by 18.7%, compared to a decrease of 20.8% across the UK.
- During this period, there were 5,319 new job postings. This number of postings is high compared
 to all local authority districts. Over the past year, this has decreased by 17.8%, compared to a
 decrease of 21.5% across the UK.

Demand and Interest Trend:



- Comparing the final week of the quarter with the same week at the start of the quarter, live postings adverts have decreased by 24.6%, whilst new job postings have decreased by 71.4%. The downward trend over the quarter signals a cooling off of the labour market.
- More recent as data shows live postings have decreased by 18.2% in the last 30 days of job posting
 activity, new postings have also increased by 71.2%. The significant drop off towards the end of
 the quarter is likely due to of the effects of seasonality, causing a slowdown in recruitment over
 the Christmas period. However, the quarterly trend shows a general downward trajectory across
 the period.
- By comparing interest quotient and demand, we can identify where there are mismatches in talent/supply and demand. Interest Quotient is ranked at a high of 1.9.



Sandwell Advertised Salary

• The advertised median salary for roles over this period in Sandwell was £31,571 – up by 6.0% from the previous year, but 7.8% less than the overall national median salary of £34,258.

Top Occupations

- The top posted occupations below account for 14.4% of all job postings in this quarter.
- Primary school teachers are the most in demand occupations, receiving the highest number of postings in the area.
- Administrators are the most in demand vacancies from the employee perspective, receiving the highest interest in terms of clicks and applicants.
- Maintenance engineers have the highest location quotient, and the highest salary.

• Reflecting the most advertised occupations, the biggest skills gaps are around 'communication', 'management' and 'engineering'.



By volume Sandwell Council have logged the most job postings, followed by Stannah.



Sandwell Total Claimants²

 Sandwell had 15,765 claimants aged 16 years and over in December 2024, an increase of 140 (+0.9%) claimants from the previous month. Compared to December 2023, claimants in Sandwell increased by 2,615 (+19.9%).


- Out of the 24 wards within Sandwell, all 24 were at or above the UK average of 3.2%.
- The wards with the highest number of claimants as a percentage of residents aged 16 years and over were Soho and Victoria at 11.0%, St Pauls at 9.2% and West Bromwich Central at 8.6%.

Sandwell Youth Claimants

 Sandwell had 2,900 youth claimants in December 2024, this is an increase of 45 (+1.6%) youth claimants since November 2024. When compared to December 2023, the number of youth claimants increased by 260 (+9.8%).

- Challenges remain with youth claimants as all 24 wards in Sandwell were above the UK average of 4.3% in December 2024.
- The wards with the highest number of claimants as a percentage of residents aged 16-24 were West Bromwich Central at 10.4% and Greets Green & Lyng and Princes End both at 10.3%.
